This book was first published by the Washington State American Revolution Bicentennial Commission in 1977. CRPF has been preparing for the reprint of this book in the past two years, with edits, updated format and photos. The author, Lorraine Hildebrand, was one of the original members of the citizens' committee which spearheaded the Chinese Reconciliation Park project.

This book documents early Chinese experiences in our state, including the "Tacoma Method," but is currently out of print.

1. Horsehair Vase from Yu Tang Ceramics (Market Value \$300)

This is a hand-thrown sugar-fired ceramic vase by local artist Curtis Yu. Curtis studied Ceramics at Western Washington University, Tacoma Community College, Whatcom Community College, and also at Quyang Dingci Chinaware Co., in northern China. The vase is measured 6.75" X 9" X 5.25".

2. Chinese Painting by Patsy Surh O'Connell (Market Value \$300)

O'Connell was born in Shanghai, China of Korean parents, and lived her early life in Korea before immigrating to America in 1963. She graduated as an Interior Designer in San Francisco and has lived in Gig Harbor since 1985. This original ink painting, in Gongbi style on rice paper and washed background with tea, is part of O'Connell's series of "nature as is."

3. Limited-edition Chinese Yixing Tea Pot (Market Value \$300)

This purple-clay tea pot was designed to commemorate the 30th anniversary (1978-2008) of China's economic reform. The tea pot's basket shape and fish-shaped lid are extremely unique and of high craftsmanship.
